Also available will be additional fabric in 3, 5 and 10 yard cuts and a variety of notions and tools to make your garment sewing easy. I am really excited to be able to carry this line. Watch for the announcement of the opening date.

If you haven't heard yet, Queen Ann's is offering a long-arm quilting service now. Call the store and ask for Rena. She does both pantographs and custom work.

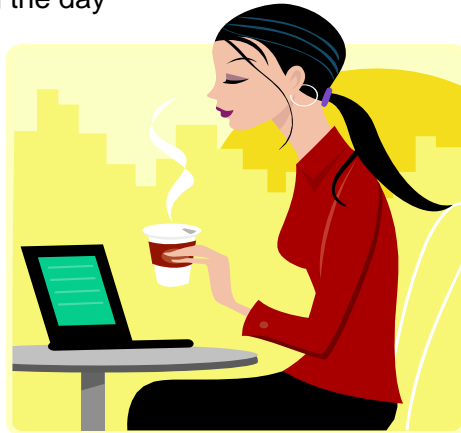

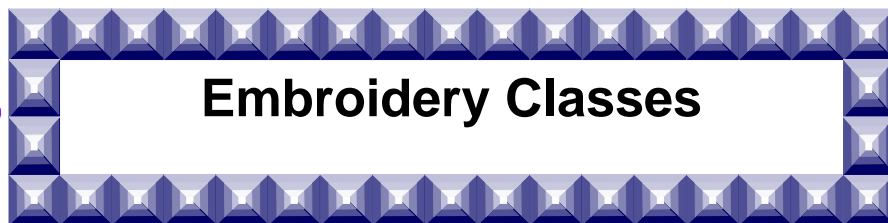

Juanita still travels to teach about four times a year and sells her work through a gallery in Missouri as well as from her home studio.

She is a Registered Nurse, a widow, with three adult children and 5 grandchildren.
